



Political Action Honor Society

Purpose: This honor society is for the entire membership of HBAL. No recognition is given in the point chart for past achievement since the basic concept is one of an ongoing political involvement each year. It is the intention of PAHS to reward those members who are actively participating in political functions. It is designed to promote participation and achievement among a large segment of our membership. This program is designed to raise political awareness and bring credit to the home building industry.

Qualification: To maintain membership in HBAL's PAHS, members must re-qualify each year by obtaining 100 points. The qualification period for membership and recognition is January 1-December 31 each year. This is a yearly qualification for all levels of political involvement (city/county/state). The program is based on the honor system, with each member completing an annual application which outlines his/her total point accumulation each year. This application must be submitted to the HBAL office for review no later than December 15 each year.
