- Builder Member (Dues: \$350 annually)**
Builders of single and multi-family residential units, commercial structures, general contractors and developers. Any person, firm or corporation that is in the business of building or remodeling homes, apartments, schools, commercial, industrial or other structures normally related to a community; or in land development.
- Associate Member (Dues: \$250 annually)**
Any person, firm or corporation engaged in a trade, service, industry or profession allied with the building industry.

The Lincoln Home Builders Care Foundation's mission is to support the educational and charitable activities of the Home Builders Association of Lincoln. The Foundation strives to support the community by contributing to community service projects focused on housing, as well as providing scholarships for students pursuing a career related to the building industry, and providing funding for other industry related educational programs.

HBAL Committees

Home & Garden Show - Since 1973, the Home Builders Association of Lincoln has sponsored the Nebraska Builders Home & Garden Show. Held every year in February, planning for this event occurs throughout the year.

Chili Cook-Off - Held every year in March, the Chili Cook-Off brings the best of the best to the kitchen. Contestants enjoy getting to know each other while preparing their chili during the day. During the event, members go from booth to booth sampling the amazing recipes. Planning for this event begins in December.

Parade of Homes - Held every spring and fall, the Parade of Homes is a great opportunity for builders to show off their work. Committee members assist in the planning as well as distribution of the Parade Guidebooks, directional signs, etc.

Golf - Two golf tournaments are held every year in June and August. Each have their own committee and planning begins 3-4 months prior to the event.

Sporting Clay Shoot - This annual event is held at the Oak Creek Sporting Club in October. It is set up like a golf tournament where teams of five travel from station to station to shoot at a number of clays released in a pre-planned sequence. Planning for this event begins in May.

HOMEPAC/Political Action Committee - Although anyone can attend these monthly meetings, voting rights require a \$100 contribution to HOMEPAC. Members of this committee interview City Council, County Commissioner, mayoral and legislature candidates, offer them financial support and work on their campaigns.

Education - Continuing education is an important part of anyone's career. The Education Committee periodically schedules classes based on feedback from members, regulation changes and issues facing the building industry.
